- *Musicianship classes are offered principally for boys who are advanced instrumentalists sitting AMEB examinations. The AMEB sets Musicianship qualifications as a prerequisite for some practical examinations.*

- *Classes typically start in Week 3 of Term I and end mid August. Attendance at all classes is expected. Homework is set each week.*
- *The course fee is \$250 (textbook included) and will be charged to your Term II account. It cannot be refunded if your son leaves the course from the beginning of Term II onwards.*
- *Examination enrolment is now the responsibility of the candidate. The School no longer enrolls boys for Musicianship examinations.*
